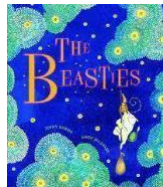
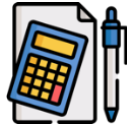

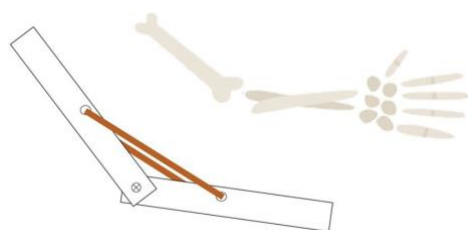

Alongside regular reading, spelling and maths home learning choose at least one of the following to complete over this half term. You might even be inspired and choose more than one!

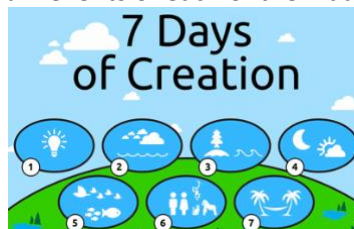
Science

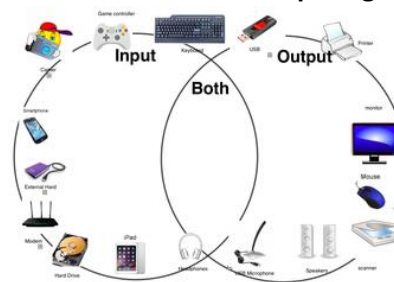
