Thank you for your continued support. Have a wonderful weekend and we look forward to another fantastic week ahead.

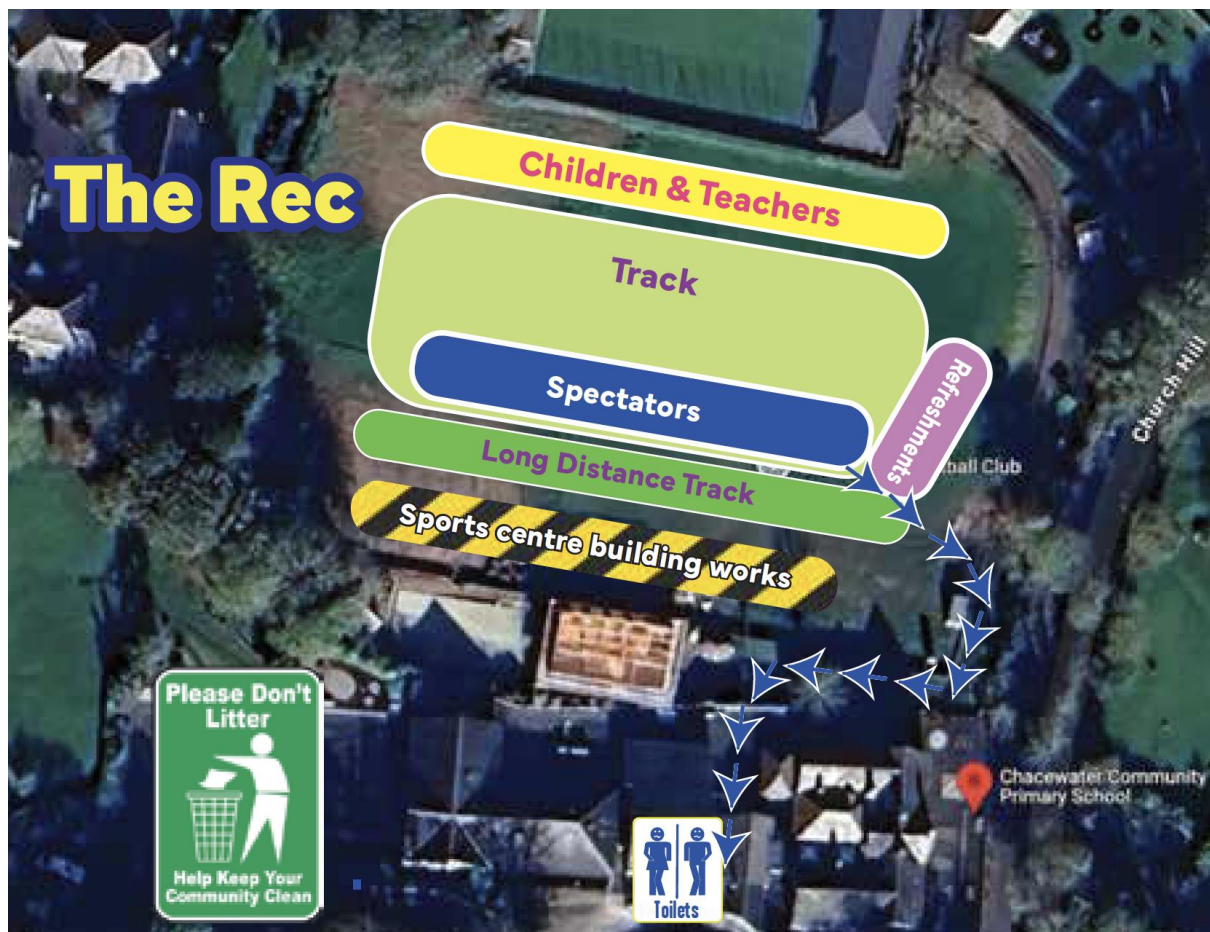

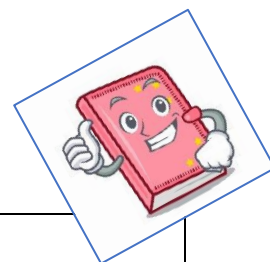
