Dear Parent/Guardian

Your child's annual nasal flu vaccination is now due

The School-Age Immunisation Service is delivering the flu immunisation programme in Cornwall's and Devon's schools on behalf of NHS England & Improvement. Flu can be a very unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

In 2023/24 all children in Primary Schools from **Reception to year 6 (inclusive)** will be offered the vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. Please enter www.nhs.uk/child-flu to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate. Please submit your consent form by **midday on Monday 16th October 2023** to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form please **telephone 01872 221105 for Cornwall schools and 01392 342678 for Devon schools** and the team will be happy to help. Please note that as in previous years **you must opt into** the programme. If a consent form is not submitted your child will not be vaccinated.

If your child becomes wheezy or has their asthma medication increased after you submit this form, please contact us on the numbers above.

If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, it would help us if you still complete and submit the consent form giving the reason. This will help us to plan and develop the service. Please tell us if you need this information in a different format.

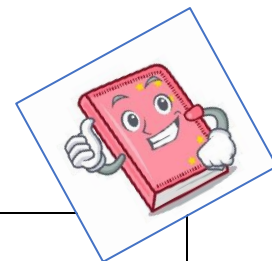

Chacewater Parish Council has an exciting opportunity to support the Council in their community work. If you have a genuine interest in helping our forward-thinking, pro-active, and energetic Council develop and deliver timely, quality and innovative services to the local community, this post is ideal. With around 1,500 households and 1,300 voters Chacewater, located between Truro and Redruth, is a rural parish which consists of numerous public rights of way, and a rich historic mining history set within a World Heritage Site.

You will ensure that all legal, statutory, financial and other governing provisions relating to the Council are observed, all Council meetings are properly administered, and decisions effectively implemented whilst developing healthy working partnerships with key local and regional bodies.

If you have not been involved in working with Councils before, look to your transferable skills and how these can benefit our Council. The successful applicant will have a proven record in administration and financial management with experience of managing people (volunteers or employees). You will be required to attend monthly evening Council meetings which are usually held on Wednesday/Friday evenings and other meetings as needed. This may involve some weekend work during the year. The day-to-day hours can be agreed to fit around you and can be flexible throughout the year depending upon workload.
