On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term in Seedlings Class.

Mathematics

Place Value within 20

We will be learning how to count forwards and backwards within 20, and how to read and write numbers in numerals and words. We will understand the 'ten and a bit' structure of teen numbers.

Addition and Subtraction within 20

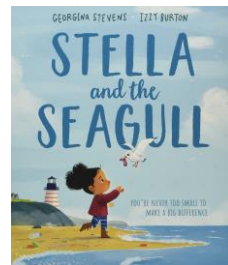
This term we will learn how to add and subtract within 20 using a range of strategies, such as looking for number bonds and using a number line.

Number and Place Value within 50

We'll be counting in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s to 50. We'll count in 1s forward and backward starting at any number within 50. We'll focus on 2-digits as tens and ones, find one more and one less, compare and order numbers within 50.

English

We will be reading the book 'Stella and the Seagull' by Georgina Stevens. We will continue to focus on always using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops when writing a sentence. We will practice thinking about what we want to write before we write it, and using different adjectives to describe how the characters in the book look and feel.



Science: Animals including humans.

We'll be using observation skills to compare and contrast animals and identify their category: mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish. Then we'll group them into carnivore, herbivore and omnivore. Humans are animals too! We'll learn about parts of the body and explore our senses.



Art & Design: Painting – Printmaking

We'll be looking at different ways to make prints using paint. We will use our bodies, different objects, and relief plates made of Styrofoam. We will learn about the three primary colours, and experiment with colour mixing.

Computing: Programming a Robot

We'll be learning how to programme a robot using the BeeBots app. We will learn what codes are, and how to create a set of instructions for the BeeBot to follow.

Religious Education:

What do Christians believe God is like?

We will look at different parables from the Bible, and discuss what they teach Christians about God.

RHSE: Caring for others – Our Special People

We will explore why they are special and how they care for and keep one another safe.
