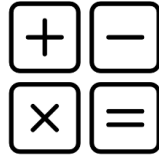

- division



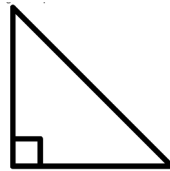
Time :

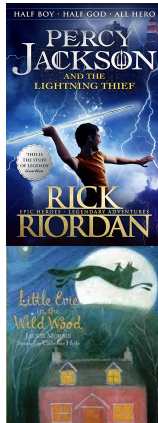
Reading- Class Novel: Percy Jackson and the lightning thief by Rick Riordan

History and RE

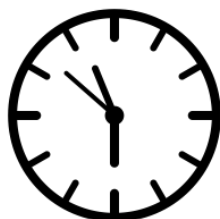
The ancient Greeks believed in many Gods. Create a poster about an Ancient Greek god or Goddess:
