As a school and within our Trust we will monitor guidance from the Department for Education with regards to arrangements for the funeral and all schools within the Trust have been requested to pause social media during the period of national mourning for the Queen's death.

We share this quote from a 14-year-old Princess Elizabeth, from her broadcast to the children of the Commonwealth in October 1940:

"And when peace comes, remember it will be for us, the children of today, to make the world of tomorrow a better and happier place"

In school today, we have continued to keep the day as normal as possible but have provided opportunities for the children to talk about the Queen and remember her life, in an age appropriate way. This afternoon, we will hold a brief assembly to reflect on the sad news but more importantly celebrate her life.

As further guidance is released I will update you. Currently our intention is to continue with school life as usual to give children the routine that they need, whilst at the same time providing any emotional support that may be needed.

Dear parents and carers,
