On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term.

Mathematics: Place Value and Number

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 4 digit number: Th, H, T and O
- Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000
- Find 100 more and 100 less than a given number
- Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- Counting back past 0 into negative numbers
- Revising formal written calculation methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Number Fluency:

• Revising previously learnt times tables including division facts: 2x, 10x, 5x, 11x, 3x and 4x

Science: Animals including humans

- Name the parts of the digestive system in humans
- Describe the simple functions of the organs in the digestive system
- Identify the functions of the different types of teeth in humans
- Understand the effect sugary drinks have on teeth
- Construct and interpret animal food chains





D.T: Food

• Design, make and evaluate a bread-based product with a filling e.g a sandwich, wrap or roll.



French: Phonetics & revising fruit

- Pronunciation of french sounds e.g 'ch' 'ou' 'ille' 'ique'

 Grammar: writing sentences with more than one clause using a range of conjunctions, use and understand pronouns and possessive pronouns e.g I, he, they, mine, his, theirs.

- Can we believe everything we read online?




