

Children should read at home for 20 – 30 minutes every day as part of their homework.




- Children will take a star reader assessment every half term to assess their 'range' zone of proximal development.

- Children earn points through quizzing to complete their individual reading target each half term.



On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term.

Mathematics: Place Value and Number

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a 4 digit number: Th, H, T and O
- Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000
- Partition flexibly numbers to 10,000
- Find 100 more and 100 less than a given number
- Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000
- Counting back past 0 into negative numbers

Number Fluency:

Revising previously learnt times tables including division facts: 2x, 10x, 5x, 3x, 4x and 8x

English

Reading: The Twits by Roahl Dahl (Class Novel) Writing:

Write a fact file about a chosen animal from British wildlife

Grammar:

- -writing sentences with more than one clause using a range of conjunctions
- use and understand pronouns and possessive pronouns e.g I, he, they, mine, his, theirs
- Revising when to use the determiners: a or an, Writing expanded noun phrases to describe using adjectives and commas in a list

Spelling:

- Homophones words that sound the same but have different spellings
- Words starting with prefixes: 'in', 'il' 'im' ir' 'sub' and 'inter
- Year 3 and 4 statutory challenge words

Science: Animals including humans

- Name the parts of the digestive system in humans
- Describe the simple functions of the organs in the digestive system
- Identify the functions of the different types of teeth in humans
- Understand the effect sugary drinks have on teeth
- Construct and interpret animal food chains

- Real P.E. Develop the fundamental skills: 1 leg balance and footwork patterns including skipping and hopscotch forwards and backwards.




