






As a staff team we have been thinking more about how we can implement the most up to date educational research into how children learn - using cognitive science to help inform our approaches

to teaching and learning, particularly exploring the link between working memory and long-term memory. Understanding that working memory is limited, so key knowledge and skills need to be practised to achieve automaticity/rapid recall. To support this, we are using a range of strategies to help children's ability to retrieve key knowledge.



We are really pleased to have successfully been able to appoint a new teaching assistant this week, Miss Jodie Bawden, who will be working in the Young Oaks in the morning and with Seedlings in the afternoon. We are delighted to have her as part of our team.

#### EYFS parent meeting – 7<sup>th</sup> October

We are so proud of how well are new Acorns have settled into their reception year – they are doing brilliantly! On Friday 7<sup>th</sup> October Mrs Cookson will be leading a short meeting for parents/carers to update you on learning, routines and how you can best support at home. This will take place at the end of the school day in the classroom. We will be able to look after the children in another classroom during this short meeting.

#### Phonics meeting with Mrs Morgan – Tuesday 4th October

As mentioned above, Mrs Morgan will be leading a meeting to update parents and carers on our approach to teaching phonics and how you can best support this. This meeting is predominately aimed at parents and carers of children in Seedlings and Buds (Y1 and Y2). It will take place at the end of the school day.

#### **Parent Meetings**

We will be holding parent/carer meetings in the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> October. We will get sign up sheets out for this soon.

#### <u>Times Tables Rockstar Day – 7<sup>th</sup> October</u>

On Friday 7<sup>th</sup> October we will be inviting all of our children to come dressed as a Rockstar for the day, while we have a focus on times table and number facts. We will use this day to relaunch TTRS and also to get children started with Numbots. On this day we will also be having a 'maths magician' in school which is very exciting.



#### **Pupil Premium**

Pupil Premium funding is additional funding which the school receives for each eligible pupil and allows us best support the children both academically and across the wider school curriculum e.g. trips and residentials.

Your child may be eligible for free school meals and pupil premium funding if you are in receipt of one or more of these benefits:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods).
- Income Support (IS)
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)

#### Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Supports

Please note that **all** reception and key stage 1 children are entitled to a free school meal **but** the school will not receive any additional funding if an application is not made.

#### **Chatterbox**

Due to essential and important safeguarding training for all staff on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> October we are unable to run Chatterbox on this day. We apologise for the inconvenience this causes but this training is crucial.

#### **Class Photos**

We have booked Harlequin photography to take individual pupil photos on October 4<sup>th</sup> in the morning. All children to wear school uniform to school on this day even if it normally a PE day. We hope that siblings will be able to have photos together if desired.

#### **Data Collection & Photo Permissions**

We will be sending home data collection sheets over the coming week in order to make sure we have the most up to date and accurate information on our system. Please check these carefully, make any changes on the sheet and return to the school office.

We will also be sending a new photo permission form home, which is being used across all of the schools in our academy trust. This form asks for permissions in several areas. Please note that opting out of any of these areas means that we will be unlikely to use your child's photo in most of what we do, due to the overlap in where images are used i.e. the newsletter is also published on the website.


