Swimming – rapidly approaching – Y5



We are really pleased that we will be able to take our Y6 children (Mighty Oaks) swimming in over a two-week block – week beginning **17th June and 24th June**. Y5 (Red Oaks) will be swimming the weeks beginning **1st July and 8th July**.

The children will swim every morning at Truro Leisure Centre and will be taught by trained swimming instructors. We will travel by coach each day and hope that parents/carers will be able contribute towards the cost of transport through ParentPay at an equivalent of £2.50 per day.

The children will need a swimming hat, goggles and a towel for these sessions. **Please note that the leisure centre have stipulated that the children are not allowed to wear jewellery in the pool.**

Change of Dates

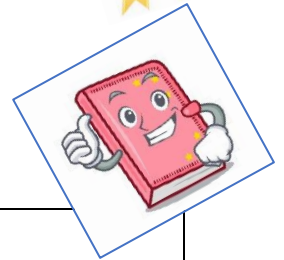
Please note that we have had to change a couple of dates at the end of the term.
