On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term in the Acorns class.

Maths:

We will be learning about shapes and we will explore how shapes will appear when rotated and explore which shapes need to be selected to complete a task developing our spatial reasoning skills.



- **Focus on the cardinality, ordinality and counting to 20 and beyond.**
- **Subitising – to 6, including in structured arrangements.**
- **Composition – '5 and a bit'**
- **Composition - of 10**
- **Comparison – linked to ordinality**
- **Play track games**

PSED:

Managing self: exercise, meditation, relaxation, what it means to be a safe pedestrian, and understand the importance of healthy food choices.

Understanding the World: This half term we will be learning all about the importance of caring for our environment, through the exploration of plants. Understanding what plants need to survive and the differences between fruits and vegetables.

Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them.

Physical Development gross and fine motor movement/ PE:

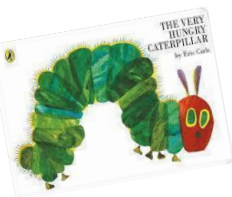
Develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently. Suggested tools: pencils for drawing and writing, paintbrushes, scissors, knives, forks and spoons.

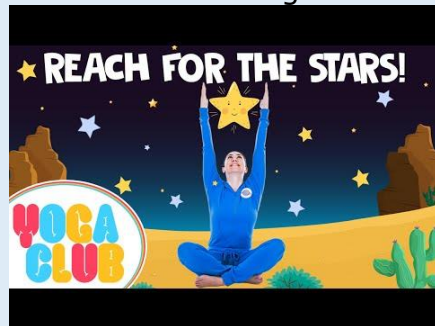

Developing our scissor skills. Throughout this term we will continue to develop our scissor skills. Can you practise these skills at home?



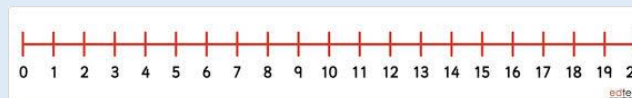
Make your very own hat or crown.
