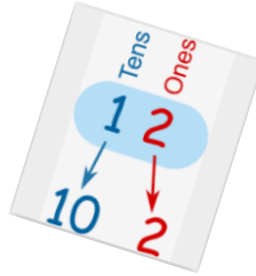
Class: Year 2 (Buds)

Theme: What do I need to me be?

On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term in Buds.

Maths:

- Count objects to 100 by making 10s.
- Recognise tens and ones
- Use a place value chart
- Partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100 in words
- Flexibly partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100
- 10s and 1s on a numberline to 100



Science: Animals including humans

Children will learn that animals produce young called offspring and that some animals have young that don't look the same. They will look into healthy living and carry out an investigation into how exercise affects the human body.

Religious Education:

What is the 'good news' Christians say Jesus brings?

- Children will understand and recognise stories from the bible and understand the link between 'Gospel' or 'good news'.

RHSE: Happy healthy friendships

- This sequence of lessons will be exploring healthy and happy friendships, focusing on forming friendships and what makes a good friend.

English:

- Our class text is based around the novel written by Roald Dahl: The Magic Finger.
- We will continue our learning in our phonic groups to secure our knowledge of sounds and apply these within our writing.



Grammar:

How words combine to make sentences.

- Introduction to capital letters, full stops ... to demarcate sentences.
- Capital letters for names and for the personal pronoun.
- Sequencing sentences to form short narratives.

Computing:

Children will understand the uses and benefits of information technology in the wider world as well as in school. To understand how to be safe when using IT and how IT can be used in different ways.

Art:

Children will begin to understand knowledge of landscape and know how to create different textures.

PE:

Outside: children will learn how to travel with a ball, bouncing and dribbling and how to maintain possession and avoid attackers. Inside: children will practise coordination and footwork, travelling in a range of different ways in different directions while maintaining balance and speed.

Understand that we can join two sentences together using the words and, or, but; when this happens, we have constructed one sentence with two clauses (a compound sentence).

- understand that when a subject is repeated, it can either be replaced with a pronoun or omitted: George loves chocolate but (he) hates ice cream.
