## Mighty Oaks- Might Bakers!

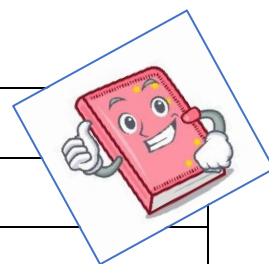
This week we were amazed by our brilliant Y6 bakers. They have evaluated different breads, deigned and baked their own. Yum!
