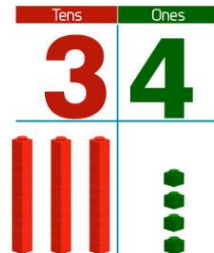
Theme: What do I need to be me?

On this page you will find an outline of our learning this half term in Buds.

Maths:

Place value:

- Count objects to 100 by making 10s.
- Recognise tens and ones
- Use a place value chart
- Partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100 in words
- Flexibly partition numbers to 100
- Write numbers to 100
- 10s and 1s on a numberline to 100



Science: Animals including humans

Children will learn that animals produce young called offspring and that some animals have young that don't look the same.

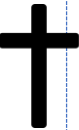
They will look into healthy living and carry out an investigation into how exercise affects the human body.



Religious Education:

What is the 'good news' Christians say Jesus brings?

- Children will understand and recognise stories from the bible and understand the link between 'Gospel' or 'good news'.



RHSE: Happy healthy friendships

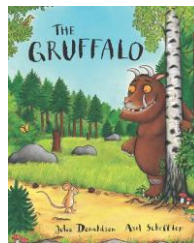
This sequence of learning focuses on how pupils experience, name, and manage a wider range of feelings such as excitement, frustration, worry, and sadness. Pupils build on their emotions toolkit, adding new strategies for managing their feelings.



English:

Text - The Gruffalo by Julia Donaldson

Outcome - To write our own character description



Computing:

Children will understand the uses and benefits of information technology in the wider world as well as in school.

We will also learn how to be safe when using IT and how IT can be used in different ways.

DT:

To be able to research, plan, make and evaluate our own healthy wraps.



Grammar focus: We will be focusing on present simple tense, using coordination: 'and', but 'and' focusing on our sentence types: statements and questions. We will also be using expanded noun phrases to add detail and to describe nouns further.

Text - I Love Bugs by Emma Dodd

Outcome - To write our own descriptive poem

Grammar focus: We will be focusing on punctuating our sentences, capital sentences and fullstops, using capital letters for names and the personal Pronoun 'I'.



PE:
Outside: children will learn how to travel with a ball, bouncing and dribbling and how to maintain possession and avoid attackers.



Inside: children will practise coordination and footwork, travelling in a range of different ways in different directions while maintaining balance and speed.

Geography: Where are the continents and oceans of the world?
We will be learning about the different continents and oceans around the world.
