Please be aware that tree removal works that are required to build the new centre will be taking place on the top end of the recreation ground from Saturday 25th May.

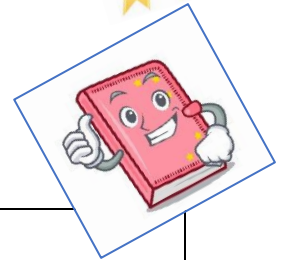
