Plan to regrow famous tree

The Sycamore Gap tree was a famous tree that grew in the middle of a gap in Hadrian's Wall, Northumberland, for 300 years. Last year, someone illegally cut the tree down and the police are still investigating. Scientists now have a plan to regrow the tree, by taking twigs and seeds from the original tree to try and grow new versions of it. The seeds are being grown in a secret lab, but it will take hundreds of years for a new tree to grow as tall.

The area, Bexhill-on-Sea, is a known treasure trove of fossil and footprint finds. Vicky Ballinger, who discovered the tracks with her children, said: "I believe they are iguanodon footprints. They're not T-rex tracks because they weren't in England." The local museum will investigate the footprints.


